I campaigned hard for our new University Technical College and for more apprenticeships for Crewe and Nantwich.

Locally since 2010 over 5,000 apprenticeships have been funded by the Government, preparing our youngsters for skilled work for life.

And, most recently, the Railway Exchange Training

Academy has announced that it will be opening its doors to train young people so that they are ready to start work as railway engineers straight away - a concept I have supported since 2008.

EDWARD TIMPSON RUNS MARATHON TO RAISE MONEY FOR MRI SCANNER AT LEIGHTON HOSPITAL



Edward Timpson, Conservative Parliamentary Candidate for Crewe and Nantwich, has completed his eleventh London Marathon in a time of 3hrs 56mins 42secs.

A long-standing supporter of Leighton Hospital, Edward was running the marathon in aid of their MRI Scanner Appeal.

Has it been difficult balancing training for a marathon with campaigning? How have both been going?

Yes! Pounding the streets knocking on doors is not quite the same as marathon training, but I've been squeezing training runs in as a bizarre form of relaxation during the campaign.

What did you think of your run time?

I think I've been fastest MP before, but this year that wasn't going to happen! My personal best is 3 hours 42 minutes - last year, so I wasn't far over it, astonishingly. Talking to my constituents has been my top priority. Perhaps I should invite them on training runs with me in future!

Who are you running for and how much are you looking to raise?

I'm running for the Leighton Hospital MRI Scanner Appeal. Their current scanner is in constant use, so I'm helping them raise £1million for an extra one.

My three children were all born in that hospital, so I have a strong attachment to it, and I've campaigned successfully for major funding for them in the past, so want to keep the effort going!

I'm looking to raise about £3,000 and am well on my way to bringing that in.

As this is the eleventh London Marathon you have done, what is it about this event that keeps drawing you back?

It's a great way of raising money for and awareness of good causes, particularly as it's not the sort of thing politicians normally do. Also I've got a bit of a reputation for it now, so I suspect people would ask why I didn't do them any more if I stopped!

I did have a break for one year, when I did the Nantwich Triathlon with my wife, Julia. A bit of variety doesn't hurt, and it was great to be able to support a local event too.
